

## “No Boundaries” Assistant

### **A. Profile**

1. Has a heart for God, with a willingness to serve Children’s Ministry.
2. Demonstrates Christian maturity, expressing fruits of the Spirit.
3. Is a team player, cooperative and flexible.
4. Shares the vision of the Children’s Pastor and the Kid's Quest staff to serve children and their families.
5. Possesses a work ethic that honors God.
6. Has a teachable, joyful spirit and a desire to learn gracefully from others.
7. Is a role model for the children.

### **B. Job Description**

1. Be a classroom “buddy” to a special needs child. This may include such activities as helping the child physically to do the classroom tasks; adjusting a lesson plan to the abilities of the child, handling bathroom breaks, etc.
2. Partner with the parents to encourage your assigned child to a fuller understanding of God and principles of the Christian life.
3. Help prepare for class each week by reviewing the lesson. Advise Kids Quest staff of other items needed to make class successful.
4. Keep in close contact with Assistant Children’s Pastor and the No Boundaries Team Leader regarding any issues or concerns.
5. Be punctual and prepared, arriving at least 15 minutes before class starts.
6. Lift up your child and their family in prayer.
7. Keep No Boundaries Team Leader aware of any scheduling conflicts or illnesses as soon as possible so a substitute can be found.
8. As God leads you, become a support to the family of your child.
9. Be knowledgeable of all rules, policies and procedures.
10. Have fun with your child and watch him/her grow as they see you model Christ to them.
11. Attend at least one worship service or one adult ABF class each week.
12. Pray for the No Boundaries ministry, the Kids Quest staff and Fairfield Christian Church.
